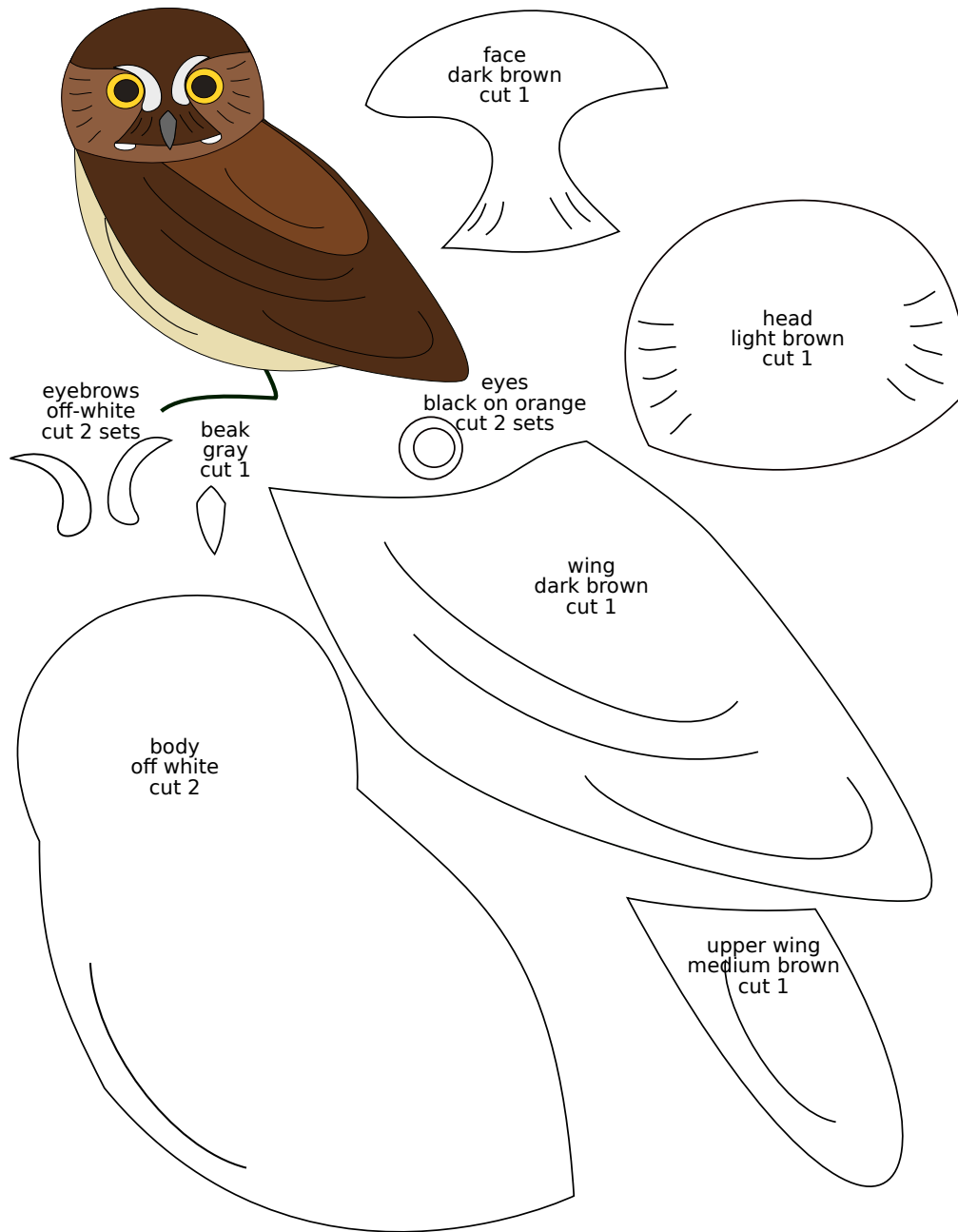


# Downeast Thunder Farm Elf Owl



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Position and pin the wing and upper wing onto the body front. Sew decorative stitching to hold in place.

Position head and face onto body front, overlapping wing; pin. Position beak and tack in place with a running stitch from top to bottom with one strand of black embroidery floss. Position eyes; tack in place with black floss. Position eyebrows; tack in place with a running stitch using one strand of white embroidery floss.

Add the decorative stitching on the whiskers and around the face using one strand of black embroidery floss. With three strands of white embroidery floss, add a few stitches on the edge of the whiskers.

Pin the body front to the body back. Sew together with a blanket stitch pausing to stuff with fiberfill before completing. Fashion the legs from a length of wire folded in half and twisted. Tuck the wire between the body front and back.
