



Position the wing on the body front and add the decorative stitching.

Position the head on the body front and sew a running stitch along with very edge with two strands of white embroidery floss. Position the face on the head so it extends beyond the boundary of the head. Sew a running stitch along the very edge with white embroidery floss.

Position the crest at the top of the head so it overlaps the face. Sew on with a running stitch along the edges in either black or dark brown embroidery floss.

Place the orange eye circle over the black eye piece and tack into place with a French knot using three strands of black embroidery floss. Position the beak in place and tack with a running stitch down the middle using black floss. Add the decorative stitches to the belly.

Sew the body front and back together with a blanket stitch, pausing before you finish to stuff with fiberfill. Fashion feet out of a piece of wire if you like.
