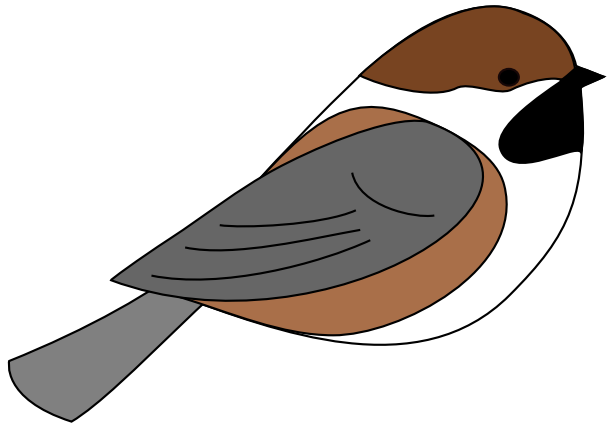


Downeast Thunder Farm Boreal Chickadee

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Create two mirror images of the bird to sew together so you'll end up with a double-sided bird with the tail sandwiched in the middle.

Position the tail on the wrong side of one of the body pieces; tack into place. On the right side of the body, position the belly and wing. Add the decorative stitching on the wing effectively holding both into place.

Position the cap and pin. Add a trio of black French knots for the eye. Position the chin in place and tack with black floss. Add the beak and tack into place.

If desired, fashion legs from wire and tack onto the wrong side of the body. Pin the body front and back together and sew around the edges with a blanket stitch using black floss, pausing to stuff with fiberfill before completing.
