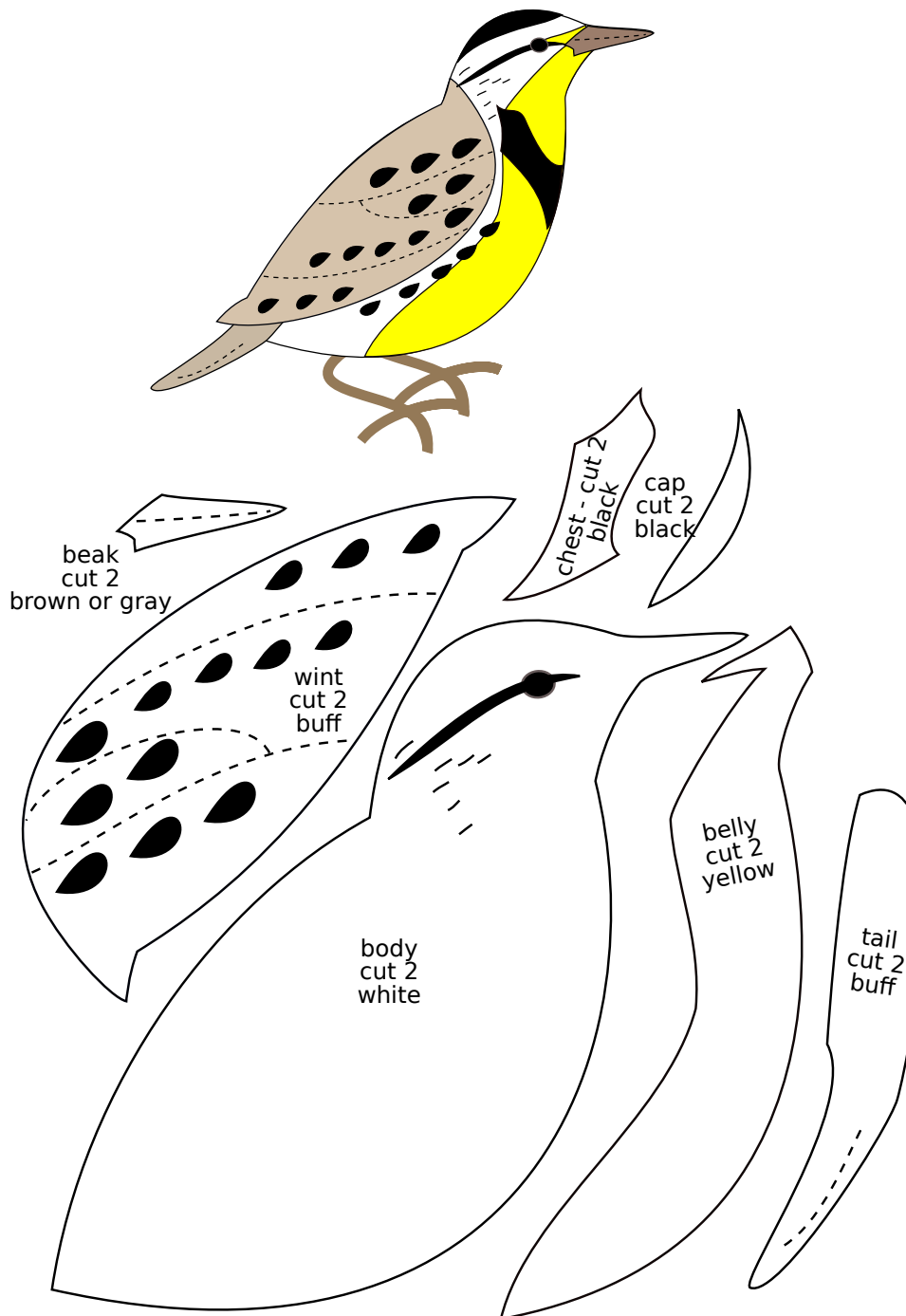


Downeast Thunder Farm Meadowlark

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Position the tail and wing into place; pin. Add the decorative stitching as pictured using varying size laisy daisy stitches for the tear-drop shapes..

Position the yellow belly and tack with matching floss. Add the chest and tack with black floss. Add the laisy daisy stitches to the belly as pictured.

Tack the cap into place. Cut a circle of black for the eye; tack into place. I created the black line that runs through the eye with a series of long stitches in black floss. Add the beak and tack into place with a running stitch down the center.

If desired, fashion legs from wire and tack onto the wrong side of the body. Pin the body front and back together and sew around the edges with a blanket stitch using black floss, pausing to stuff with fiberbill before completing.
