

# Downeast Thunder Farm Rose-Breasted Grosbeak

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Create two mirror images to sew together so you'll end up with a double-sided bird with the tail sandwiched in between.

Position the breast and wing so the wing slightly overlaps the breast; tack. Position the beak and sew into place with a running stitch using two strands of black floss for the mouth. Cut an oval of black felt for the eye and tack into place. Sew the decorative stitching onto the wing with three strands of white floss.

Add the decorative stitches to the belly using two strands of black floss. Tack the tail to the wrong side of one of the body pieces. If desired, create wire legs and tack to the wrong side of one of the body pieces.

Pin the body front and back together and sew the edges together with a blanket stitch using two strands of black floss, pausing to stuff with fiberfill before completing.
