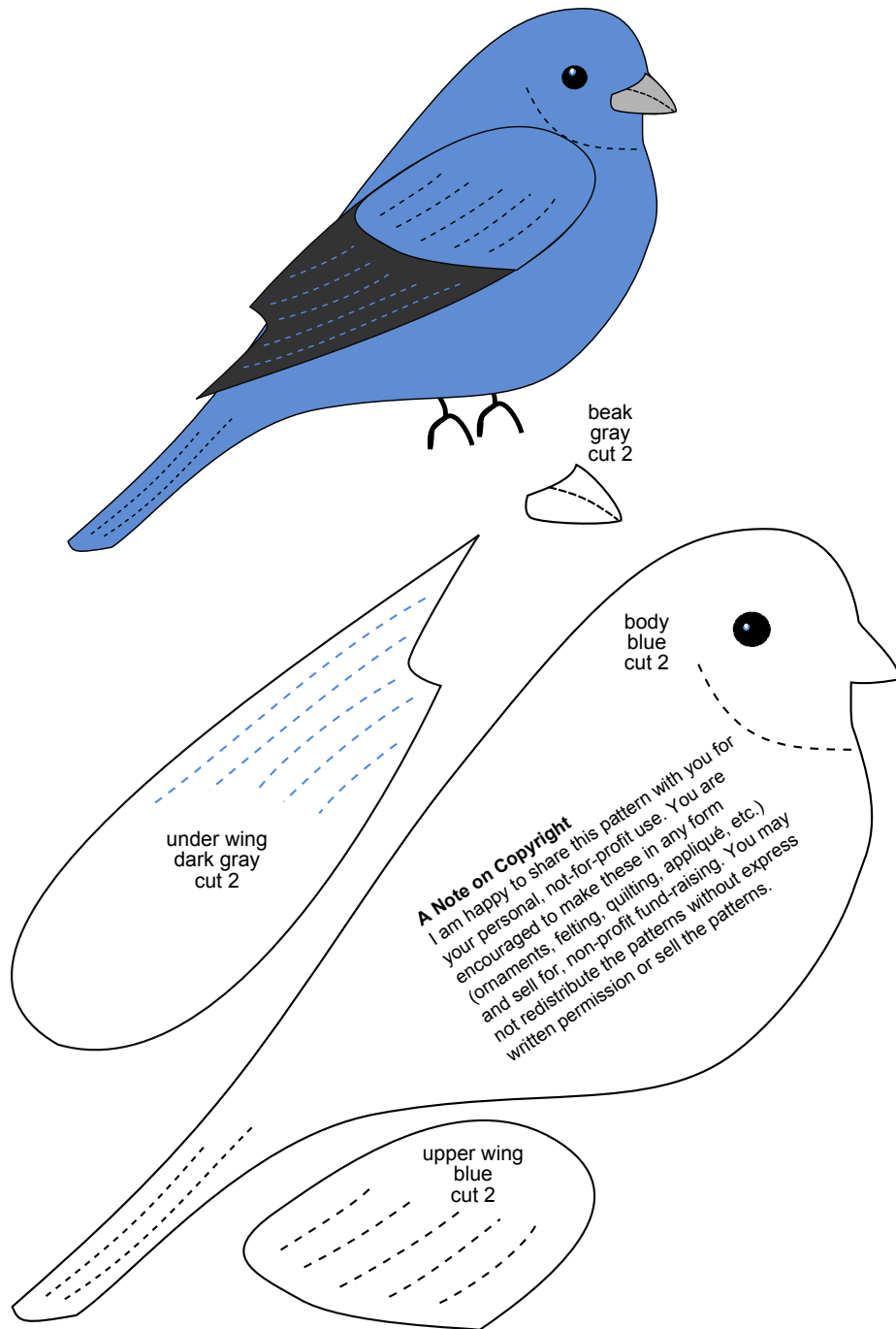


Downeast Thunder Farm Indigo Bunting

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For this bird create two mirror images to sew together so you'll end up with a double-sided bird.

Position the underwing and upper-wing into place. Add decorative running stitch to the upperwing with two strands of black embroidery floss. For the decorative stitching on the underwing, use two strands of a matching blue floss.

Cut a circle of black felt for the eye; tack into place with a black running stitch through the center of the eye. For some added interest, sew one black glass seed on the eye. Position the beak and tack with a black running stitch for the mouth.

If desired, create wire legs and tack to the wrong side of one of the body piece.

Pin the body front and back together and sew the edges together with a blanket stitch using matching blue floss, pausing to stuff with fiberfill before completing.
