

Downeast Thunder Farm Fox

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Start this fox by sewing the black ear tips on both the front and back body pieces with one strand of black embroidery floss. Next, add all the white pieces (ears, face, belly, and tail) with a running stitch along the edges using one strand of white embroidery floss. Add the tail to the back body piece in the same manner.

Add the legs using a running stitch around the edges with one strand of black embroidery floss. Add the decorative stitch from the left leg with one strand of black embroidery floss.

Tack the nose into place. With one strand of black embroidery floss, add the whiskers and mouth. For the chin decorative stitching, use one strand of off white or light brown floss. The eyes are made with French knots and an adjoining stitch. I used four strands of black embroidery floss to create the French knots.

Pin the body front and back together and sew the edges together with a blanket stitch using black floss, pausing to stuff with fiberbill before completing.
