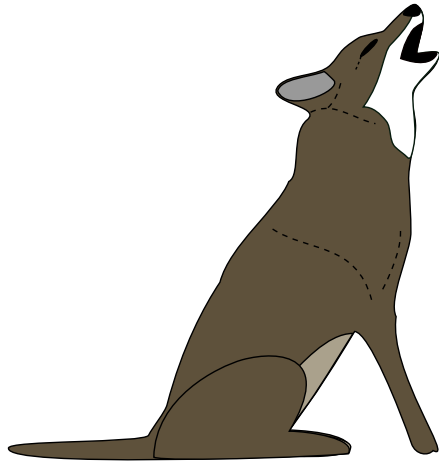


Downeast Thunder Farm Coyote

Create two mirror images of the coyote to make a double-sided ornament.

Tack the belly and ear into place with one strand of matching embroidery floss. Tack the throat into place with one strand of white embroidery floss.

Pin the hind leg into place and attach it with a blanket stitch running along the inside part of the leg. In order to blend with the heathered look of the felt, I mixed two strands of embroidery floss - one tan and one gray.

Using two strands of black embroidery floss, create the eye. Add the decorative stitching around the chest and neck using the mixed two strands of embroidery floss used on the leg.

The nose and mouth are so small that it's difficult to cut pieces from felt. I pinned the body front and back together and then sewed the nose on using a satin stitch, sewing through both the front and back body pieces. Do the same for the mouth. For both the nose and the mouth, use three strands of black embroidery floss.

Sew the edges together with a blanket stitch once again using the two strands of mixed thread. Pause before completing to lightly stuff with fiberfill.
