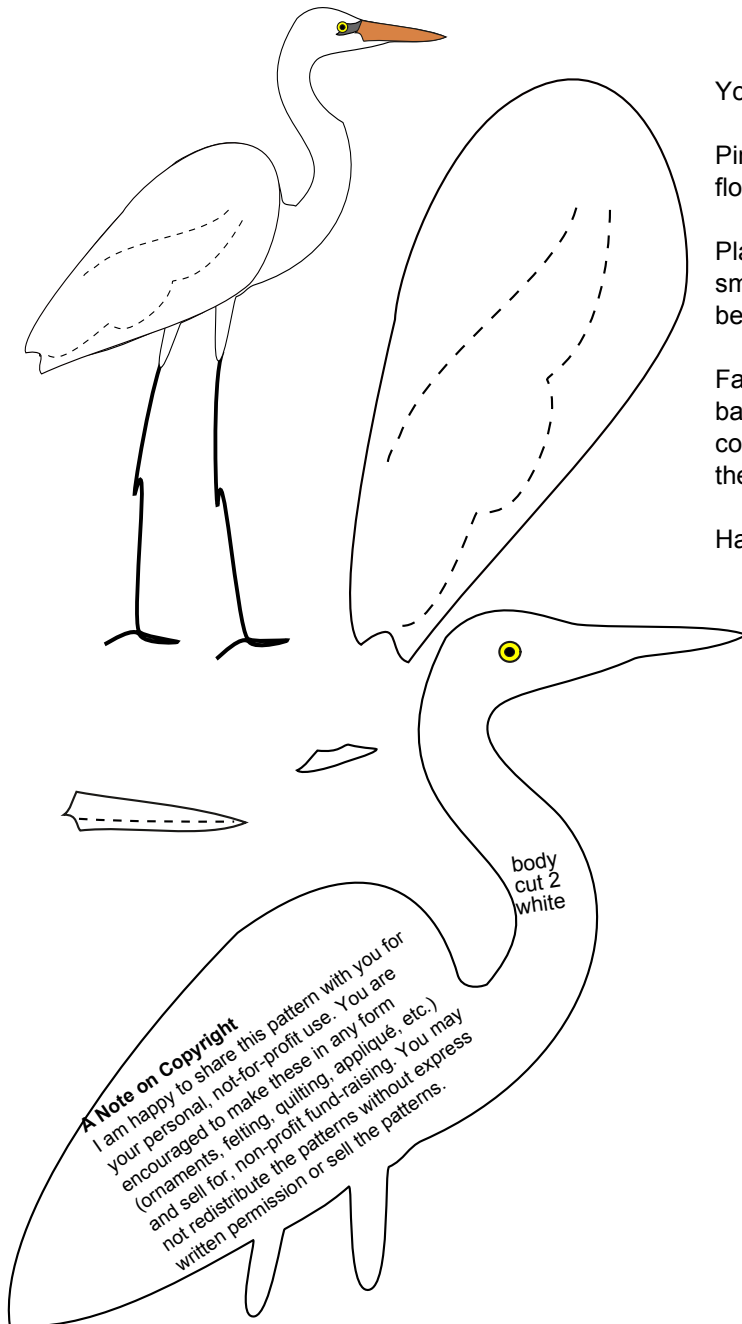


Downeast Thunder Farm Great Egret

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You'll make two mirror images of this bird that you will sew together to create a double-sided bird.

Pin the wing onto the body and sew the decorative stitching using three strands of white embroidery floss.

Place the beak and tack with a running stitch for the mouth using one strand of light brown floss. Cut a small circle of yellow for the eye. Layer the eye and face onto the body. Tuck the face piece under the beak. Hold both pieces in place with a black French knot in the center of the yellow eye.

Fashion wire legs and tack them to the wrong side of one of the body pieces. Pin the body front and back together and sew the edges together with a blanket stitch, pausing to stuff with fiberfill before completing. Use two threads of matching floss around the beak and two threads of white floss around the rest of the bird.
