

# Downeast Thunder Farm Common Goldeneye Duck

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You'll make two mirror images of this bird that you will sew together to create a double-sided bird.

Position the cheek and head onto the body; tack with a white running stitch along the edges of the cheek using one strand of white embroidery floss. Position the bill and tack with a stitch using black embroidery floss. Cut a small circle of yellow felt for the eye. Tack with a small French knot using black embroidery floss.

Position the back and wing into place; pin. Using three strands of black embroidery floss, add the decorative stitching to the wing and belly. Position the tail on the wrong side of one body piece; tack.

Tack the foot to the feet to the wrong side of one of the body piece. Pin the body front and back together and sew the edges together with a blanket stitch using two or three strands of black embroidery floss, pausing to stuff with fiberfill before completing.
