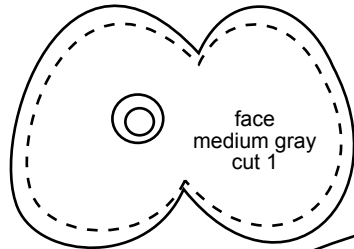
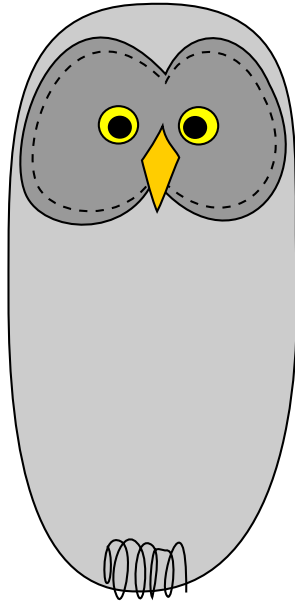

You may not redistribute the patterns without express written permission or sell the patterns.

Position the face on the body front. Attach with a running stitch in black along the outer edge of the face piece. Tack beak into place. Position the yellow eyes and tack into place with either a black French knot or a black glass seed bead. Pin the front and back together and sew the outer edges with a blanket stitch, pausing to lightly stuff with fiberfill before finishing.
