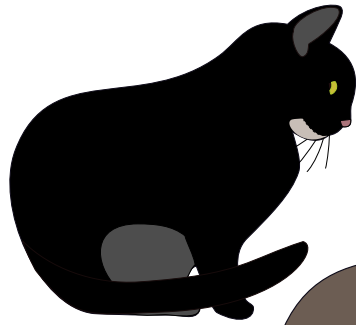


# Downeast Thunder Farm Kitty

Snape Kitty

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Cinder Kitty

The colors on this pattern match my Cinder, but you can mix up the colors any way you like. Black would make it a Snape kitty - both kitties are found at Downeast Thunder Farm.

Create two mirror images for a double-sided pattern. Note: I used one strand of floss throughout the body front. I used two strands of floss for the edge blanket stitching.

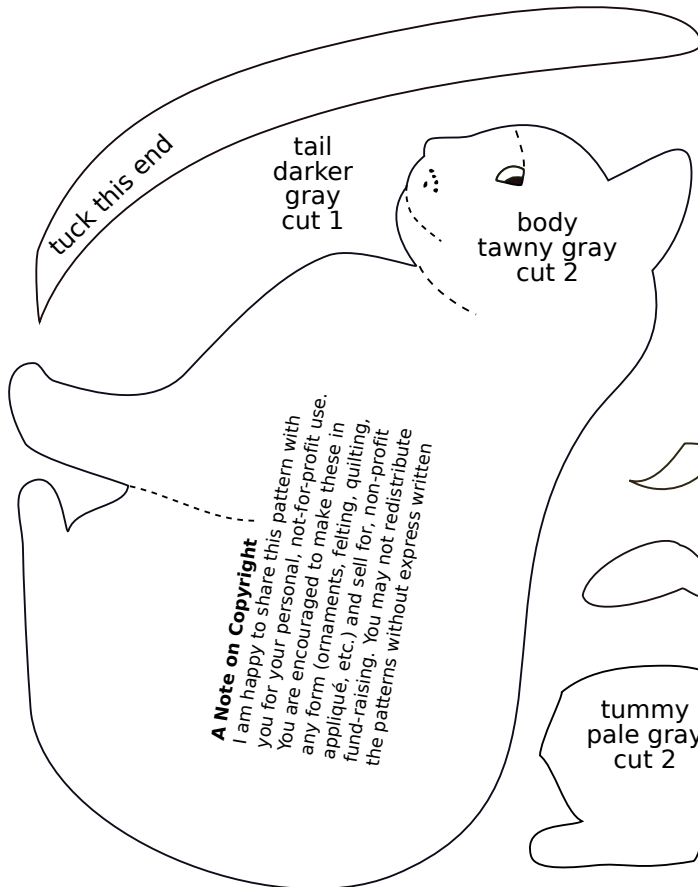
Position the ear, chin, and tummy and tack each piece into place with a running stitch around the edge using matching floss for each piece. Add the decorative stitching as noted on the pattern including the eye which in this case is a mix of black and green.

Tuck the end of the tail between the body pieces and tack from the inside. Wrap it around the outside to curl around the kitty's legs. For the whiskers, I tucked small pieces of wire through the cheek area of the felt. On the end of the wire that rests on the inside, I curled a small loop to keep it from falling out. I'd love to hear of other ideas for handling the whiskers!

Pin the body front and back together. Sew the edges together with a blanket stitch, pausing to stuff with fiberfill before completing.
