

Downeast Thunder Farm Skunk

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Create two mirror images of the pattern for a double-sided skunk. Position the back piece on the body and sew a running stitch around the edges with one strand of white floss. Cut a small circle of black for the eye and attach with a black seed bead.

Sew the decorative stitching to form the ears and claws using gray floss.

Pin the body pieces together, right side out. With three strands of gray floss, add the nose with a repeated satin stitch, sewing through both body pieces. Sew the rest of the together with a blanket stitch using two strands of black floss. Before finishing the blanket stitching, pause to lightly stuff with fiberfill.
