Note: I use two strands of floss throughout this ornament.

Begin with the claws. Sew the decorative stitching around the "knuckles" of the claw with black or brown floss. Sew the claw front and back together with a blanket stitch using matching colored floss. Lightly stuff the claw "pincher" part with fiberfill.

On the body front, add the decorative stitching as shown using black or brown floss. Sew two small black glass seed beads on for the eyes.

The claw, legs, and tail pieces are stitched on the wrong side (or inside) of the body back so they become sandwiched between the two body pieces when finished. On the wrong side of the body back, position the claws and tack with matching colored floss. Position the legs and tack to the body back. Align the tail pieces and tack to the inside or wrong side of the body back.

I used wire for the antannae tacked to the inside of my lobster - although I think you could do without the antennae all together.

Sew the body pieces together with a blanket stitch using matching colored floss. Pause before finishing to lightly stuff the lobster body with fiberfill.
