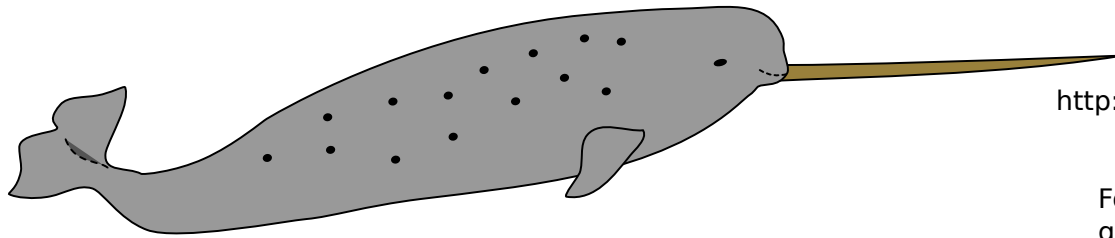


# Downeaster Thunder Farm Narwhal



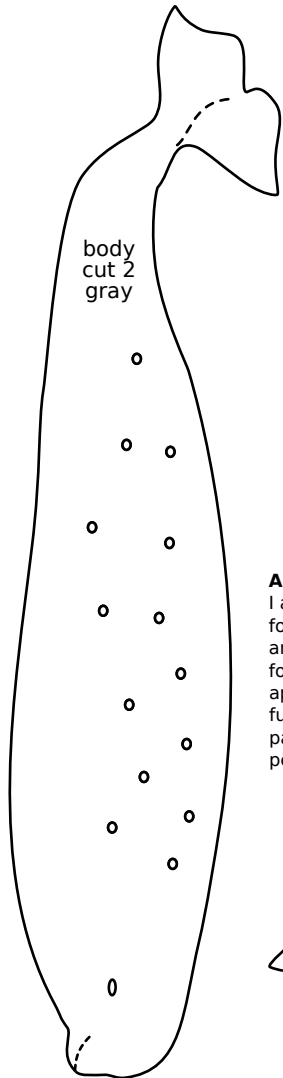

Create two mirror images of this whale for a double-sided ornament.

With two strands of black floss, add French knots on the body for the "spots". Create the tale and mouth definition with black running stitches. Use black or gray glass seed bead for the eye. Tack the fins to the body with a gray blanket stitch along the top.

For the "tooth" take an 8" long piece of wire (I used 20-gauge aluminum craft wire with an antique brass finish). Gently bend the wire in half so it's shaped like a "u" at the bend. Holding the "u" end and begin twisting the two pieces of wire around each other; continue until the two pieces are twisted to the end.

On the back side of one of the body pieces, position the tooth; tack it in a couple of spots to keep it in place. Sew the two body pieces together with a gray blanket stitch, pausing to lightly stuff with fiberfill before finishing.
