

Downeast Thunder Farm Gray Whale

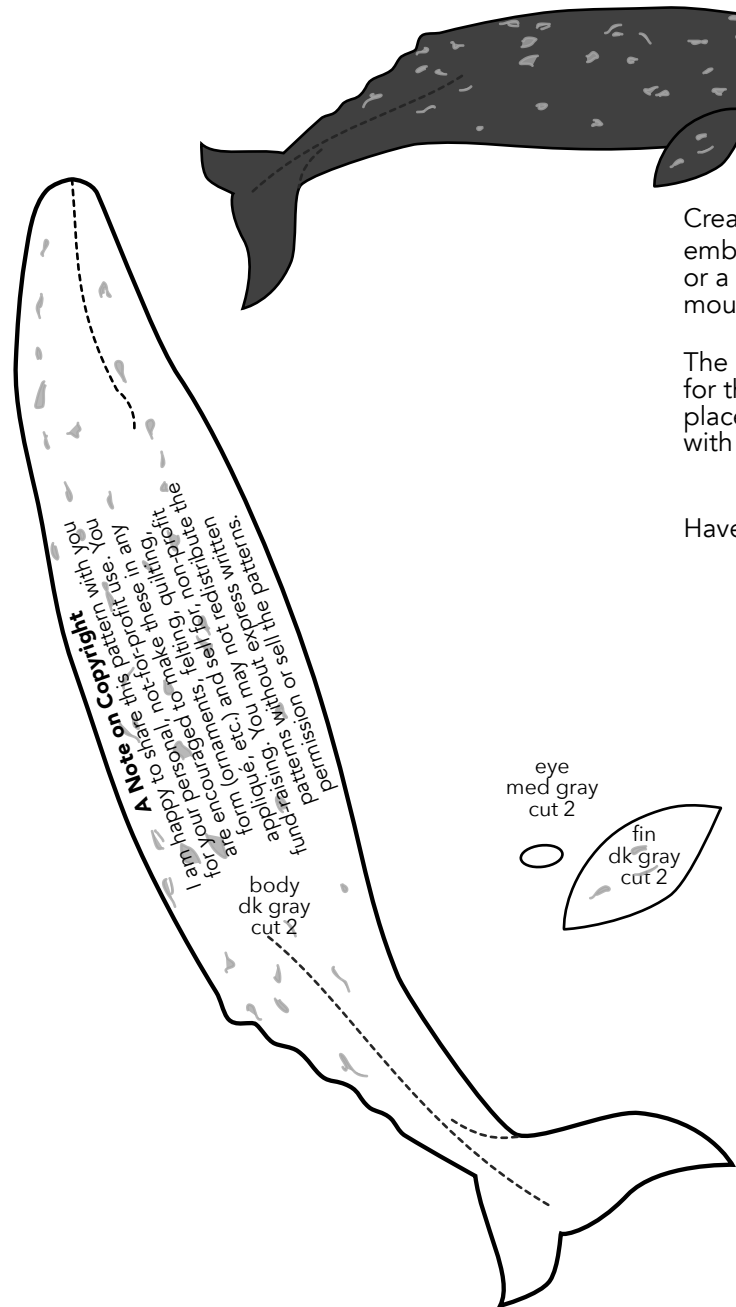
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Create two mirror images of this whale for a double-sided ornament. Note: I use two strands of embroidery floss throughout. Position the gray oval for the eye. Tack with a black or gray seed bead or a French knot. Add a black running stitch under the eye and down to the nose to create the mouth. Add the black running stitch along the tail as outlined.

The gray whale has whitish spots all over its body. I played with french knots and lazy daisy stitches for the spots, but ultimately decided to use clear seed beads to create the spots. Tack the fins in place. Sew the body front and back together with a blanket stitch in gray floss pausing to lightly stuff with fiberfill before finishing.
