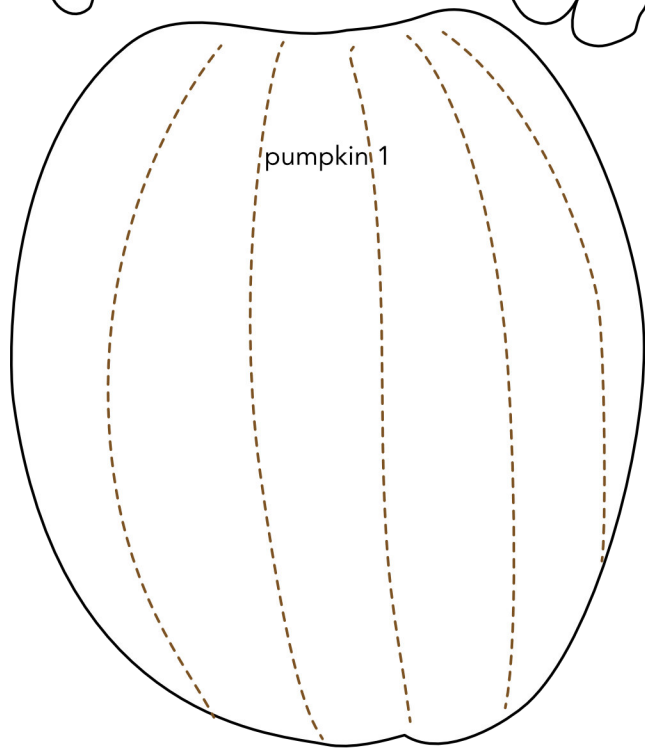
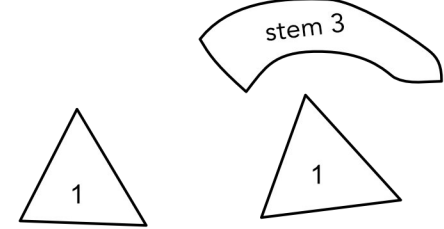
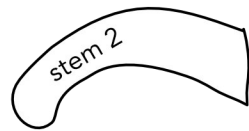
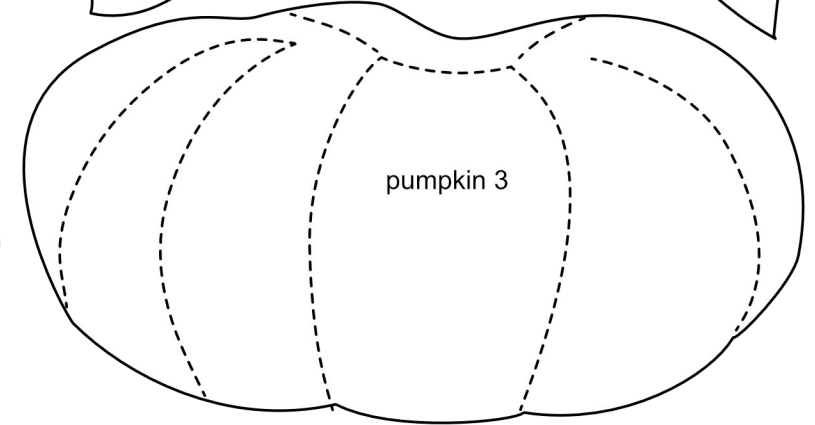
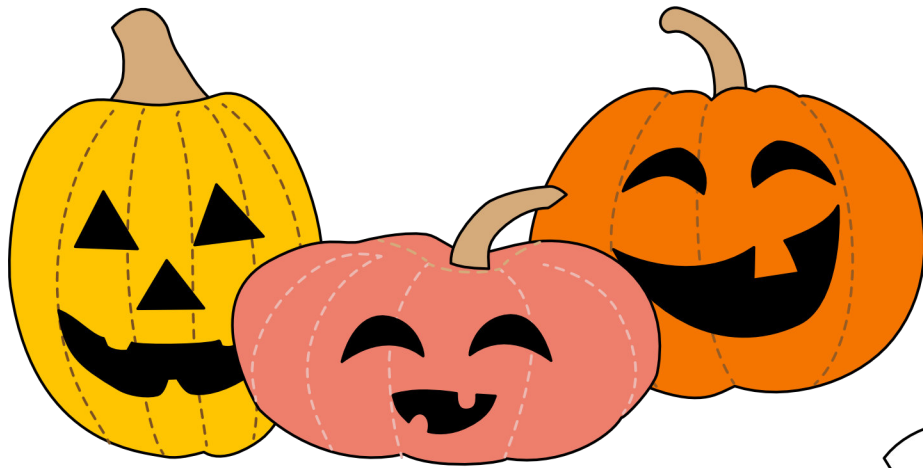
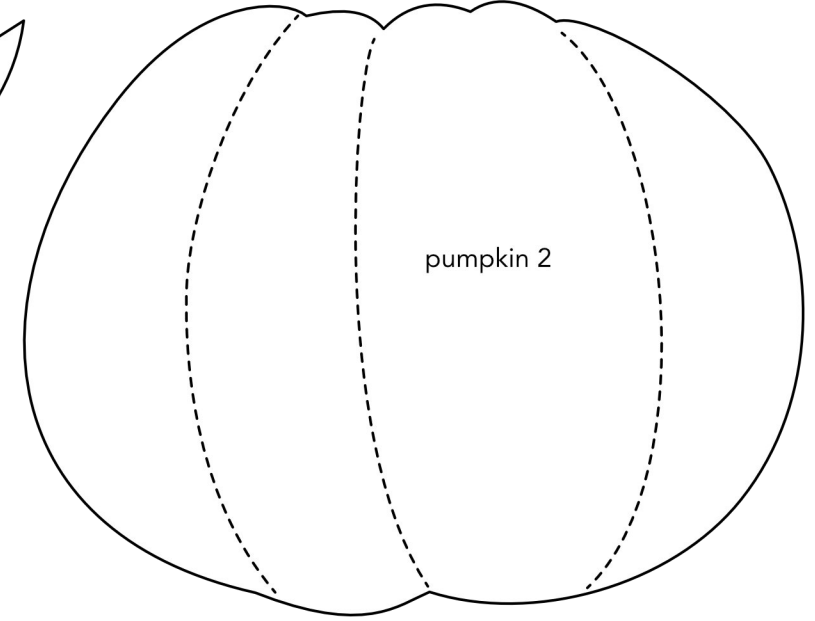
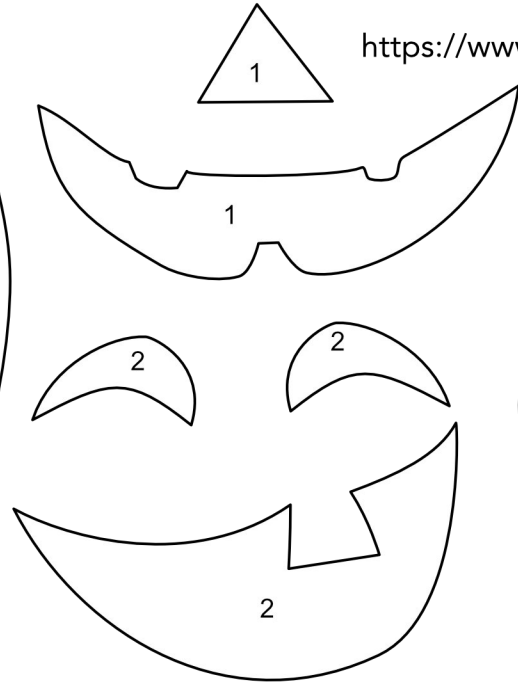


Downeast Thunder Farm Pumpkins & Jack-o'-lanterns

These Jack-o'-lanterns can be standalone ornaments used as decorations or consider stringing them on a Halloween garland. Make them from felt or autumn-themed fabrics backed with fusible interfacing.

Instructions

- Cut two of each of the pumpkins and stems from your color choice of felt. While pumpkins are most commonly orange, they also come in white, green, yellow, and blue.
- Cut one each of the faces from your color of choice - or design your own face. You can use black as shown here or a yellow/gold as if the Jack-o'-lantern is lit from within.
- Sew the decorative running stitches on the pumpkins with your choice of floss using one strand. Depending on the pumpkin you're creating, use a darker or lighter orange floss for the detail.
- Sew the faces with a running stitch around the edges using one strand of matching color floss.
- For pumpkins 1 and 2, sew the two stem pieces together with a blanket stitch using two strands of matching floss. Tack it to the inside of the pumpkin back.
- For pumpkin 3, position the stem on top of the pumpkin and tack with a running stitch along the bottom using matching colored floss. Repeat on the pumpkin back aligning the stems so they match when sewn together.
- Sew the two pumpkins together with a blanket stitch using the floss color of your choice, either a matching color or a contrasting color. 1.5" from the end, pause to lightly stuff with fiberfill and finish.
