

Downeast Thunder Farm Brown Creeper

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Note: Use two strands of floss unless otherwise noted. Create two mirror image sides for a double-sided bird.

- Position the back on the body. Sew along the inside edge with a brown running stitch.
- Position the wing and tack along the inside edges with a brown running stitch.
- Position the beak and tack with a black running stitch for the mouth.
- Position the eye and tack with black floss. Sew a white backstitch around the eye. Finish off with a black seed bead (optional).
- With white floss, add the decorative straight stitches on the back and wing. The wing uses lazy daisy stitches in both black and white.
- On the body, add the brown stitches with one strand of floss.
- If desired, create the feet with a piece of wire and tack to the back of one body.
- Sew the two bodies together with a blanket stitch matching the floss color to the felt. Pause 1.5" before finishing and lightly stuff with fiberfill. Finish stitching and tie off.
