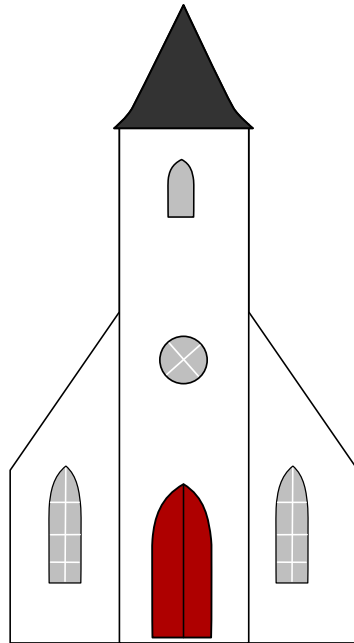


Downeast Thunder Farm Little White Church

- Use light gray felt for all windows. Use two strands of floss throughout - dark gray, white, and red as appropriate.
- Position the church front over the body front. Sew with a white blanket stitch along the sides (not the steeple area).
- Position the door. Sew with a red blanket stitch around the edges. Add the decorative stitching down the center.
- Position the windows. Sew on with a blanket stitch around edges and add decorative stitching, as illustrated.
- Around each window and door, sew a white running stitch just a tiny bit past the edge of the window/door to mimic trim.
- Position the roof. Tack with a gray blanket stitch along the bottom edge.
- Create a matching version for the back, replacing the door with a window.
- Using two strands of matching floss (white along the church edges, gray along the roof), sew the two sides together with a blanket stitch. Before you finish the blanket stitch, pause to lightly with fiberfill.
