

# Downeast Thunder Farm Yellow-rumped Warbler

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For a double-sided ornament, create two mirror images of this pattern. Use two strands of floss unless otherwise noted. Position the back on the body; tack along the inside edge with black floss. Position the face and tack with a one strand of black floss. Position the beak and tack with dark gray floss. Position the eye and tack. Add the white stitch details above and below the eye.

Position the chest and tack along the inside edge with black floss. Position the yellow belly and tack with white floss. Position the wing; pin. Position the upper wing; add decorative stitching using black floss.

Tuck the yellow rump under the wing; tack with white floss. Add the decorative stitching to the wing, tail, and chest using white floss. Add the black running stitch to the white portion of the belly.

On the back of one of the body pieces, tack on the wire for the legs.

Match the two body pieces together and sew the edges together with a blanket stitch. Use white floss on the white felt and black everywhere else. Pause when 1" before finishing and lightly stuff with fiberfill.
