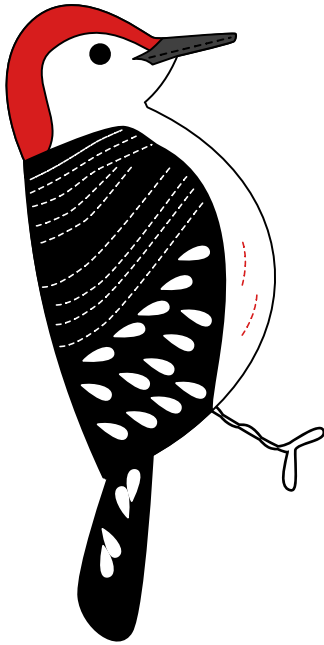


Downeast Thunder Farm Red-bellied Woodpecker

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- Create mirror versions of the bird for a double-sided ornament.
- Position the cap and tack with matching floss.
- Position the tail and tack with a few stitches. Add the lazy daisy stitches using three strands of white floss.
- Position the wing and add the lines with a split stitch. Using the same floss, add the lazy daisy stitches.
- Position the eye and tack with a black seed bead. Position the beak and tack with matching floss.
- With bright red floss, add the stitches to the belly.
- Fashion legs from wire and tack to the back of one of the body pieces.
- Using two strands of floss that matches the felt (black white, red gray), sew the body pieces together with a black blanket stitch, pausing about 1 inch before finishing and lightly stuff with fiberfill.
