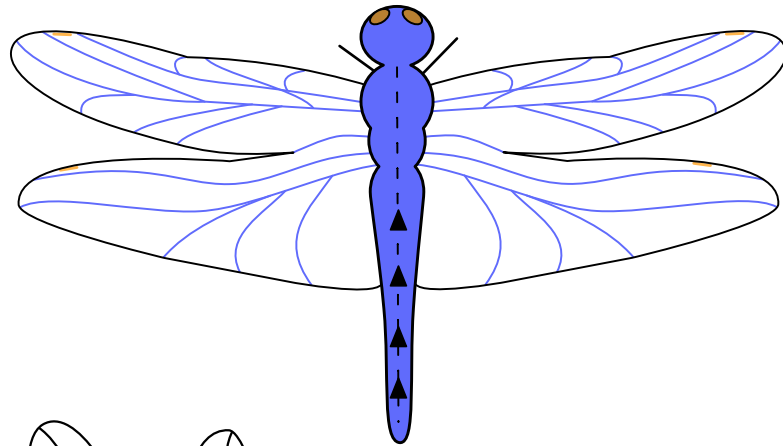


Downeast Thunder Farm Dragonfly

There are so many varied colors of dragonflies. Let your imagination guide you with the colors for this pattern.

- Cut two of each pattern part. Use one strand of floss throughout.
- With blue floss, add the decorative stitching to the wing.
- Add the decorative stitching to the body with black floss.
- Tack the eyes or use bead for the eyes.
- Fold a 1" piece of wire for the legs and tack to the bottom of one of the wings.
- Position the body on the wing and pin. With two strands of blue floss, tack body onto the wing with a blanket stitch. Repeat for the back side.
- Position the two body pieces together.
- Using two strands of floss, sew the front and back together with a blue blanket stitch around the body, and white blanket stitch along the wings.
