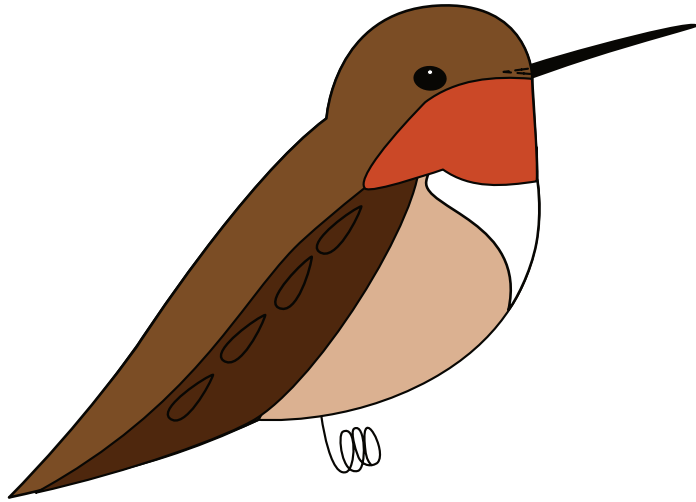


# Downeast Thunder Farm Rufous Hummingbird

- Create two mirror images of the hummer for a double-sided bird.
- Position the chest and tack with white floss.
- Position the back and tack with brown floss.
- Position the wing and tack with a black running stitch. Add the lazy daisy stitches in black to the wing.
- Position the throat and tack with brown floss.
- Position the eye; tack with black floss and finish off with a black seed bead if desired.
- With black floss, add the stitches above the throat.
- Paint a round toothpick black. Position it to the back of the body and tack it into place.
- Create the legs with a length of wire. Tack the back of the body.
- Sew the two bodies together with a blanket stitch using two strands of brown floss. If desired, pause before finishing to lightly stuff with fiberfill.
