



Downeast Thunder Farm Ovenbird

- Position back and tack with matching floss.
- Position the wing and add the decorative stitching to the wing and tail using matching colored floss.
- Position the eye and stitch along the outside edge with white floss.
- Position the beak and tack with a running stitch for the mouth.
- Add the orange backstitch to the head.
- Add the running stitch to the head with matching colored floss.
- Using four strands of black floss, add split stitches to create the belly decoration.
- On the back of one of the bodies, add wire legs if desired.
- Create a mirror image of the bird for the back.
- Sew the two sides together with a blanket stitch using white on the belly and matching floss along the head/back. Pause before finishing to lightly stuff with fiberfill if desired.
