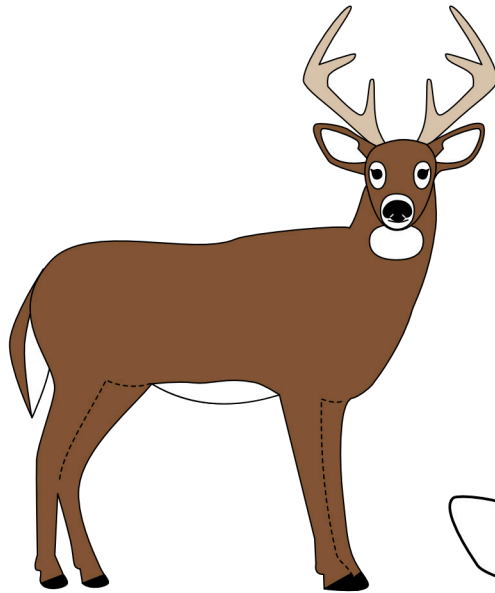


# Downeast Thunder Farm White-tailed Deer

- Match the antler pieces. Tack around the edges with beige floss; set aside.
- Sandwich the brown tail between the two white pieces; tack together at the top; set aside.
- Position the face; tuck the neck slightly. Tack the neck with a white running stitch.
- Tack the face with a brown running stitch.
- Tack the ears, under-eyes, mouth, and under-belly with white floss.
- Tack the nose in place with black floss.
- Sew on black seed beads for the eyes or a black French knot. Add a black stitch for the eyelash.
- With two strands of black floss, sew the decorative running stitches that define the legs. Tack the hooves.
- Create the back by adding the hooves and belly.
- Tack the antlers to the inside of the body with a brown running stitch.
- Use two strands of brown floss to sew the bodies together (excluding the tail and antlers) with a blanket stitch. Pause 1.5" before you finish to stuff the body lightly.
