

Downeast Thunder Farm Blackburnian Warbler

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- Sew the decorative stitches on the tail (both pieces) with one strand of white floss. Match the pieces up and tack them to the back of one of the bodies.
- Create two mirror images of the bird for a double-sided ornament.
- Position the head. Tack along the bottom edge with a black running stitch. Position the face and cap; tack each with black floss. Position the beak and tack with a black running stitch for the mouth. Add a black bead for the eye.
- Position the wing. Tack with a black running stitch along the edge. As illustrated, add the decorative back, running, and lazy daisy stitches to the wing.
- With black floss, add the decorative stitches to the belly and neck with a split stitch.
- If you like, attach a bit of wire for legs to the back of one of the bodies.
- Sew the two bodies with a black blanket stitch using two strands of floss. Pause before you finish to stuff with fiberfill lightly. Finish and tie off.
