

Downeast Thunder Farm Halloween Ghost Garland

A super easy spooky season Ghost Garland!

Notes

- Use two strands of floss throughout.
- For the number of ghosts, determine how long you want the garland. You'll want about 14" of string for each ghost, plus an additional 8" on each end. I used black and white baker's twine; use any string or yarn you desire.

Instructions

- Sew the eyes and mouth onto the body front using a black running stitch around the edges. Repeat for all of your ghosts.
- Position the string on top of the ghost back just below the arms; pin from the outside. Position the completed ghost front on the back, sandwiching the string in between and pin at the edges to keep the string in position.
- Sew the bodies with a blanket stitch using two strands of white floss. Pause when you're about 1½" from finishing the blanket stitch. Lightly stuff with fiberfill; finish sewing the edge and tie it off.
- Allow about 9" of string between each ghost.
