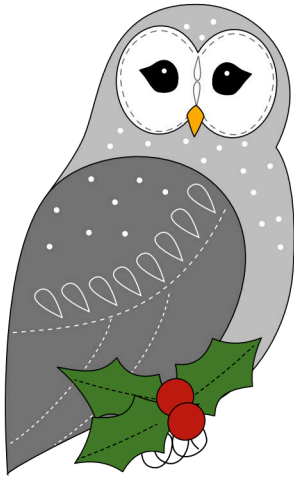


Downeast Thunder Farm Joyful Owl Ornament

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- Sew the face with one row of running stitches along the outer edge using gray floss. Sew the two lazy daisy stitches vertically in the center of the face, as illustrated.
- Using black floss, sew the eyes, finishing them with a seed bead.
- Position the beak and tack with white floss.
- Position the wing and sew along the inside edge with a blanket stitch using dark gray floss (to match the wing color). Repeat the wing on the back of the owl body.
- Using white floss, sew the decorative running, lazy daisy stitches, and French knots as illustrated on the wing.
- Sew the white French Knots on the neck and chest as illustrated.
- Fashion legs from wire and tack to the inside of one of the bodies.
- Sew the bodies together with a blanket stitch using light gray floss. Pause when you're about 2" from finishing the blanket stitch. Take small portions of fiberfill and gently stuff the ornament; finish sewing the edge and tie it off.
