

# Downeast Thunder Farm Felt Rooster Pattern

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This rooster is fun because he can be any color you choose. Our bantam roosters were the inspiration for the two variations show here.

Cut one of each piece except the body - cut two body pieces.

Tack the face to the top body piece with a running stitch in red. Position the wing and sew the "feathers" with a running stitch. Place the neck feathers so that they overlap the wing and sew the "feathers" running stitch. Sew the eye in place with a satin stitch or button.

Pin the front body piece to the back body piece. Pin the tail feathers in place running from left to right (1-4). Begin sewing the front and back together with a blanket stitch, starting at the feathers. The blanket stitch will hold the feathers in place. Proceed around the body until you reach the feet. Tuck the feet in between the body pieces and continue with the blanket stitch around the body.

Add the beak with a satin stitch.
