
Downeast Thunder Farm Winter Wren Pattern



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Position and pin in place the body and upper body. Sew on the eye (black floss) and decorative stitching above the eye (white floss). This will hold the upper body in place. Position and pin the wing in place. Sew the decorative wing stitching.

Pin the body front and body back together. Use a blanket stitch with brown floss to sew the body front and back together. Pause to stuff with fiberfill before finishing.

At the beak, insert a toothpick between the two body pieces. This will strengthen the beak. Choose lighter brown floss and wrap the beak with the floss. To keep the floss from sliding off, I dabbed a bit of glue to the back of the beak.
