
Downeast Thunder Farm Kingfisher Felt Ornament



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Pin the throat to the body front; tack with matching floss.

Pin the upper body to the body. Pin the face into place; tack into place with matching color floss. Tack a small circle of black felt into place of the eye. I use a hole punch to make the circle.

Tack the ear into place using matching floss. Pin the wing into place.

Sew the decorative stitches on the wing. The "feathers" toward the bottom of the wing are created with a backstitch in brown floss. The dots on the upper wing are French knots in a pale turquoise floss.

Tack the beak into place with a backstitch in brown.

Pin the completed body front and body back. Sew the two body pieces together using a blanket stitch. Pause to stuff with fiberfill before completing the blanket stitch.
