
Downeast Thunder Farm Long-eared Owl Ornament



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Position the face onto the body front; pin. Add the beard and crest on the face; pin. Tack the crest in place with a running stitch using on thread of black floss. Position the beak and tack with a running stitch. Cut circles of yellow and circles of black for the eyes. Complete the eyes by layering the black on the yellow and tack both into place by sewing an "x" across the black circle. With 3-6 strands of embroidery floss, sew the eyebrows and then run backstitches around the yellow of the eyes.

Pin the wing to the body top. Add the decorative stitching with three strands of black embroidery floss. Continue with the same threaded needle and add the decorative stitching to the tail.

Pin the completed body front and body back together. Use a blanket stitch to sew the two pieces together with three strands of black embroidery floss. Pause to stuff with fiberfill before finishing.

Tuck a length of wire under the wing and wrap around a branch for his perch.
