
Downeast Thunder Farm Red Headed Woodpecker

Pin the head onto the body front. Sew on a circle of black felt for the eye with a white French knot. Pin the beak into place and add the decorative stitching starting at the end of the beak and running behind the eye.

Pin the wing tip onto the wing and sew into place with black embroidery floss. Pin the wing onto the body front. Place the tail onto the bod front and tack into place with black floss, running the decorative stitching up to the wing.

Beginning at the back of the head where the head meets the wing, sew the head on with a blanket stitch using black floss.

Pin the body front to the body back and continue with the blanket stitch around the body. Pause to stuff with fiberfill before finishing.

Form the legs from a piece of wire folded into half. Tuck in between the two body pieces.
