

Downeast Thunder Farm American Woodcock Pattern

Note: For all stitching, I used three strands of embroidery floss.

Cut a large circle for the eye. Tack it on the body front and add the decorative stitching around the eye. Pin the beak into place and add the decorative running stitch down the center.

Pin the back into place on the body top; tack in a few places. Pin the wing into place and add the decorative stitching to the wing and body front.

Using brown embroidery floss, add the decorative stitching to the face and head.

Pin the completed body front and body back together. Use a blanket stitch to sew the two pieces together, pausing to stuff with fiberfill before finishing.

Create the legs with a bit of folded wire tucked between the two body pieces.
