


# Downeast Thunder Farm Great Gray Owl

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Position the face onto the body front; pin. Position the beak and tack into place. Position the mask, slightly covering the beak. Sew mask using an outline stitch along the sides with black floss. Cut black ovals and yellow circles for the eyes. Tack into place with a trio of French knots. Add two rows of running stitches around the face. With an outline stitch using white floss, make the white markings under the chin.

Position the tail feather; pin. Position the wing; pin. Sew the decorative running stitches on the wing. Add the decorative stitches to the owl's belly.

Sew the two body pieces together with a blanket stitch. Pause before finishing to stuff with fiberfill.
