
Downeast Thunder Farm California Quail



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Place the wing onto the body front; pin. The wing decorative stitches are made using a lazy daisy stitch with white embroidery floss.

Layer all of the face pieces into place on the body front; pin. Tack on the white face markings with a running stitch using one thread of white embroidery floss. Cut a small oval out of black felt for the eye; tack into place. Tack the beak into place.

Sew on the decorative stitches on the body using two threads of black embroidery floss.

Pin the body front and back together, tucking the plume between; tack into place.

Sew the body front to the body back using a blanket stitch; pause before completing to stuff with fiberfill.
