Downeast Thunder Farm King Eider Duck

eye black cut 1 bill orange cut 1 lt. blue cut 1 crest white face marking It orange cut 1 teal cut 1 cut 1 wing one black cut 1 wing 2 black cut 1 head white cut 1 body black cut 2

Begin the King Eider by positioning the white head on to the body. Tack with a running stitch in white along the inside edge - the portion that runs from the back to the chest. Position and pin wing 1 into place; tack. Position wing 2 into place and add the decorative stitching using gray floss.

Position the cap and sew a running stitch along the inside with matching blue floss. Position the crest and sew a running stitch along the edges with matching floss. Add the beak and tack into place with matching floss. Tack the eye into place and add the face marking with a running stitch down the center with matching floss.

Pin the body front and back together. Using a blanket stitch with three strands of black floss, sew around the edges, pausing to stuff with fiberfill before completing.
