
Downeast Thunder Farm Pygmy Owl

Position the head, face, and whiskers onto the gray body front. Tack the whisker piece on at the tip of the eyebrows with white floss. Make tiny snips along the bottom edge of the whisker piece. Tack the beak into place.

Position the eye black circle over the yellow circle and tack into place with black floss. Add the decorative stitching around the outer portion of the face.

Position the tail piece into place on the wrong side of the body front and tack in a location that will be hidden by the wing. Add the decorative stitching to the tail in white floss.

Position wing into place. Add the decorative stitching. I did the decorative stitching with black floss and then again just next to the black with brown floss to give it more dimension. Add the decorative stitching to the belly with brown floss.

Pin the body front and back together. Using a blanket stitch with three strands of black floss, sew around the edges, pausing to stuff with fiberfill before completing.
