

# Downeast Thunder Farm Evening Grosbeak

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Create two mirror images of the bird to sew together so you'll end up with a double-sided bird.

Position the tail in place; tack. Layer the underwing, middle wing, and upper wing in place; pin. With matching yellow floss, sew into place with a running stitch around the edges of the upper wing. With white floss, sew a running stitch around the exposed edges of the middle wing. Add the decorative stitches to the under wing in white floss.

Position the head; pin and tack into place with a black running stitch for the mouth. Tack the cap into place using matching yellow floss. Cut a circle of black felt for the eye and tack. Circle the eye with an outline stitch in yellow.

If desired, add legs formed with wire before pinning the body front and back. Sew the body pieces together around the edges with a blanket stitch using black floss, pausing to stuff with fiberfill before completing.
