Downeast Thunder Farm Snow Bunting

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stitches using one strand of pale gray floss. strands of white embroidery floss.

Follow these instructions to create two mirror images of the bird - a front and back that you will later sew together for a double-sided ornament.

Tack the beak into place with a running stitch where the mouth would be using one strand of grey embroidery floss. Use three black French knots for the eye. Add the small stitches around the mouth with one strand of light brown floss. Add the "cheek" on the face with running

Position the tail; tack. Position the wing overlapping the tail and then the upper wing; pin. Tack the upper wing in place with white floss. Add the decorative stitching to the wing using two

If desired, fashion legs from wire and tack onto the wrong side of the body. Pin the body front and back together and sew around the edges with a blanket stitch using white floss, pausing to stuff the ornament with fiberbill before completing.
