


Downeast Thunder Farm Flammulated Owl

Start this project by pinning the wing in place. Position the wing trim along the edge of the wing and tack with a series of lazy daisy stitches with off-white floss. Add the decorative stitching to the wing as pictured using dark gray floss. If desired, repeat with a second wing on the body back.

Layer the head, face, and cap together; tack the pieces together with a couple of stitches in the cap with gray floss. Position the head on the body front; pin. Position the beard and beak into place; tack with a couple of stitches in the beak. With your scissor, made some snips along the bottom edge of the beard to fluff it a bit. Add the eyes and tack into place (I used black seed beads). Angle the brows over the eyes and tack.

If desired, make some feet out wire and tack to the inside body piece. Pin the body front and back together. Sew the edges together with a blanket stitch, pausing to stuff with fiberfill before completing.
