Position the eyes on the face on the body front and then the eyes; tack with a black seed bead. Position the eyebrows and tack with a small lazy daisy stitch in brown. Using the same brown, tack the beak and add the decorative stitching around the edge of the face and neck.

Position the tail and tack. Position the wing and add the decorative stitching to the wing and tail using a running stitch and lazy daisy stitches in off-white. Add the brown and off-white decorative stitches on the belly. Repeat the wing on the back body piece.

If you like, add wire legs to the wrong side of one of the body pieces. Sew the body front and back together with a blanket stitch using off-white floss. Pause before finishing to gently stuff with fiberfill.
