
Downeast Thunder Farm Canada Warbler



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Create two mirror images of this bird for a double-sided warbler.

Tack the bottom in place. Position the back; pin. Lay the wing on the back and tack into place with the decorative stitching noted using two strands of black embroidery floss.

Cut the white and balck ovals for the eye. Tack in place and finish off with a black seed bead. Tack the beak into place.

Add the belly designs using four strands of black embroidery floss. I stitched the outline and filled in with satin stitch.

If you like, add wire legs to the wrong side of one of the body pieces. Sew the body front and back together with a blanket stitch in black floss. Pause before finishing to gently stuff with fiberfill.
