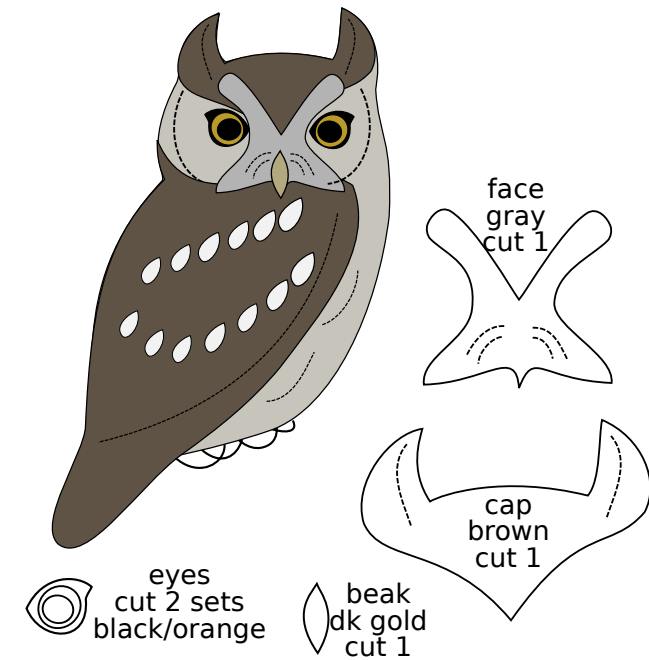


Downeast Thunder Farm Western Screech Owl

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Position the wing on the body front and tack in place with the decorative running stitch as shown using brown floss. Add the "feathers" with lazy daisy stitches in white. Position the cap and tack with the decorative stitching on the ears. Layer the face and tack discretely. Add the beak and the decorative stitches for the "whiskers".

Layer the three pieces that make up the eye and tack with black floss.

Add the decorative running stitch on the belly and the face with brown floss. For a double-sided owl, add a wing to the back body piece.

If you like, add wire legs to the wrong side of one of the body pieces. Sew the body front and back together with a blanket stitch in brown floss. Pause before finishing to gently stuff with fiberfill.
