Downeast Thunder Farm Bullfinch

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Sew two mirror images of this bird to create a double-sided ornament. Note: I used two strands of floss throughout this pattern. Begin with the belly. Tack the belly in place. Position the tail; tack. Position the underwing and mid-wing and on the body as shown; tack with white floss along the edges and at the upper tip of the wing. Position the gray back overlapping the wing; tack with black floss.

Place the cap and tack with a trio of small, black glass beads to create the eye. Position the beak and tack with a black running stitch for the mouth.

If you like, add wire legs to the wrong side of one of the body pieces. Sew the body front and back together with a blanket stitch using black floss. Pause before finishing to gently stuff with fiberfill.
