
Downeast Thunder Farm Steller's Jay

Create a double-sized ornament by making two mirror images of this Steller's Jay. Begin by placing the head on the body front. Position the beak and tack with a running stick for the mouth. Add a trio of small black seed beads for the eye. Note that I use one strand of floss throughout this ornament.

Build the wing by layering the shoulder and upper wing on the wing; position on the body and tack with a running stick in black around the shoulder. Add the decorative stitching on the wing and upper wing as illustrated. Add the decorative stitching on the tail.

If you like, add wire legs to the wrong side of one of the body pieces. Sew the body front to the body back using a blanket stitch with black floss. Paul before finishing to lightly stuff with fiberfill.
